The pattern uses UK crochet terminology, and the stitches used include:

- Single crochet (sc)
- Double crochet (dc)
- Half double crochet (hdc)
- Treble crochet (tr)

- Slip stitch (sl st)

The pattern also includes a helpful chart that provides the conversion from UK to US crochet terminology.

## **Materials**

- DK weight yarn in your desired color (approximately 500-600 yards)
- 4mm (US G/6) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

## **Gauge**

10 stitches and 10 rows = 4 inches in single crochet

## **Abbreviations**

- ch - chain
- sc - single crochet
- dc - double crochet
- hdc - half double crochet
- tr - treble crochet
- sl st - slip stitch
- st(s) - stitch(es)

## **Instructions**

### **Top**

1. Ch 100. Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across. (99 sts)
2. Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (99 sts)
3. Repeat Row 2 until the piece measures approximately 8 inches from the beginning.
4. Ch 1, turn. Hdc in each st across. (99 sts)
5. Ch 1, turn. Dc in each st across. (99 sts)

## **Sleeves**

1. Ch 35. Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across. (34 sts)
2. Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (34 sts)
3. Repeat Row 2 until the sleeve measures approximately 6 inches from the beginning.
4. Ch 1, turn. Hdc in each st across. (34 sts)
5. Ch 1, turn. Dc in each st across. (34 sts)

## **Assembly**

1. Sew the shoulders of the top together.
2. Sew the sleeves to the armholes.
3. Fold the bottom edge of the top up by 1 inch and crochet a dc border around the edge. (99 sts)

## **Pants**

1. Ch 90. Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across. (89 sts)

2. Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (89 sts)
3. Repeat Row 2 until the piece measures approximately 10 inches from the beginning.
4. Ch 1, turn. Hdc in each st across. (89 sts)
5. Ch 1, turn. Dc in each st across. (89 sts)

## **Legs**

1. Ch 35. Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across. (34 sts)
2. Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (34 sts)
3. Repeat Row 2 until the leg measures approximately 6 inches from the beginning.
4. Ch 1, turn. Hdc in each st across. (34 sts)
5. Ch 1, turn. Dc in each st across. (34 sts)

## **Assembly**

1. Sew the crotch of the pants together.
2. Sew the legs to the sides of the pants.
3. Fold the bottom edge of the pants up by 1 inch and crochet a dc border around the edge. (89 sts)

## **Hat**

1. Ch 4. Sl st to join, forming a ring.
2. Ch 1, 12 sc in the ring. Sl st to join. (12 sts)
3. Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around. Sl st to join. (24 sts)

4. Ch 1, \*sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st\* around. Sl st to join. (36 sts)
5. Repeat Row 4 until the hat measures approximately 5 inches from the beginning.
6. Ch 1, sl st in each st around. Sl st to join and fasten off.

## **Sandals**

1. Ch 15. Sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch across. (14 sts)
2. Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (14 sts)
3. Repeat Row 2 until the piece measures approximately 2 inches from the beginning.
4. Ch 1, sl st in each st across. Sl st to join and fasten off.

## **Toe**

1. Ch 4. Sl st to join, forming a ring.
2. Ch 1, 6 sc in the ring. Sl st to join. (6 sts)
3. Ch 1, \*sc in the next 2 sts, 2 sc in the next st\* around. Sl st to join. (9 sts)
4. Repeat Row 3 until the toe measures approximately 1 inch from the beginning.
5. Ch 1, sl st in each st around. Sl st to join and fasten off.


## **Assembly**

1. Sew the toe to the bottom of the sole.

2. Fold the top edge of the sole up by 1 inch and crochet a dc border around the edge.
