

How to Draw a Sunflower in Six Easy Steps

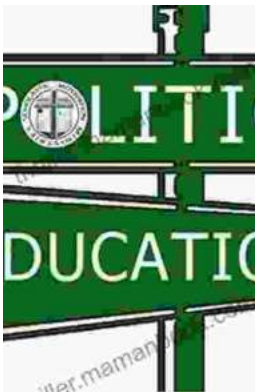
