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Materials

- 1 skein worsted weight yarn in main color
- 1 skein worsted weight yarn in contrasting color
- Size H (5.00 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle

- Pompom (optional)

Abbreviations

- ch: chain
- sc: single crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- dc: double crochet
- tr: treble crochet
- sl st: slip stitch

Instructions

Hat

1. With main color yarn, ch 4 and join with a sl st to form a ring.
2. Round 1: Ch 1 (does not count as a st), sc 6 into the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (6 sc)
3. Round 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)
4. Round 3: Ch 1, *sc in the next sc, 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (18 sc)
5. Round 4: Ch 1, *sc in the next 2 sc, 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (24 sc)
6. Round 5-12: Ch 1, sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (24 sc)

7. Round 13: Ch 1, *sc in the next sc, 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (36 sc)
8. Round 14-17: Ch 1, sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (36 sc)
9. Round 18: Ch 1, *sc in the next sc, 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (48 sc)
10. Round 19-21: Ch 1, sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (48 sc)
11. Round 22: Ch 1, *sc in the next 2 sc, 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (60 sc)
12. Round 23-25: Ch 1, sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (60 sc)
13. Round 26: Ch 1, *sc in the next 3 sc, 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (72 sc)
14. Round 27-32: Ch 1, sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (72 sc)
15. Round 33: Ch 1, *sc in the next 4 sc, 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (84 sc)
16. Round 34-39: Ch 1, sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (84 sc)
17. Round 40: Ch 1, *sc in the next 5 sc, 2 sc in the next sc; repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (96 sc)
18. Round 41-45: Ch 1, sc in each sc around. Join with a



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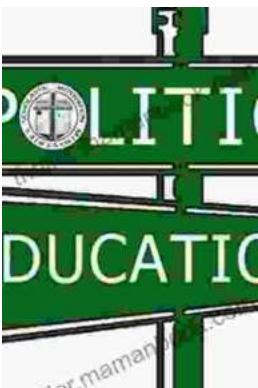
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
